### SCIENCE MEETS ART

Last week Coach Keith's sciences classes worked on drawing and labeling the human body systems. We had studied the whole body and it was to check that we had learned all of the information. It took quite a bit of effort, but it was worth the A+ on it.

### JHS Conservation Leadership Team Visits NETMWD

The 2018-2019 Conservation Leadership Team of Jefferson High School traveled to Hughes Springs recently to visit Northeast Texas Municipal Water District. Later, they traveled to Dalton's Corner for a guided tour of the Water District's drinking water filtration plant. The purpose was to learn about the water district's responsibilities and authorities as related to the operation and maintenance of Lake O'the Pines. Students also wanted to know how their drinking water was cleaned.

Water Protection Specialist Team Leader Robert Speight delivered an informative presentation to the Conservation Leadership Team about NETMWD's important functions including types of pollution and water monitoring, septic system inspection and permitting, prescribed flows for American Paddlefish reintroduction, habitat improvements through the Clean Rivers Program and the Watershed Protection Plan, and the storage and selling of drinking water to municipalities. Pete Wright, operations manager for the District, led the tour of the water plant and detailed the steps in cleaning and filtering drinking water as well as the distribution of purified water to member cities.

The Conservation Leadership Program is in its fifth year of delivery where participants can earn certification in water quality monitoring and wildlife habitat remediation through Jefferson ISD's on-going partnership with Collins Academy.
